Founded in 1960, Quail Hollow Club was originally designed by George Cobb as an exclusive 18 hole private club. Tom Fazio recently redesigned the course in 1998. Quail Hollow has hosted a PGA event nine consecutive years and will hold the PGA Championship in 2017.

Internship Program Description

The internship we offer is extensive and well rounded. Interns will receive hands on experience on all aspects of golf course maintenance and championship preparation. Everything from equipment operation to transition management will be covered. Also, students will be given leadership opportunities and will see the full extent of maintaining a course at tournament level. On top of the experience gained from tournament preparation and daily course maintenance, we offer staff training seminars twice a month taught by the Golf Course Superintendent, Assistant Superintendents, and Technicians. These educational meetings cover topics including: Irrigation, SubAir Systems, Budget, Calibrations, and Chemicals/Fertilizers Application.

All levels of knowledge and experience are encouraged to apply; however, our organization demands the highest level of dedication, self motivation and commitment.

Incentives

Wages range from \$9.00-\$11.00 an hour. Employee golf privileges, uniforms, and lunch are provided. Housing is available. It is our goal for each intern to experience a second tournament as a volunteer. We have had students work at the US Open, US Women's Open, PGA Championship, AT&T National Championship, Greenbrier Classic, US Amateur, Walker Cup, Wyndham Championship, Women's USGA Amateur, Northern Trust Open, Crump Cup and The Barclays.
