- **Title-** Summer Intern
- **Hours-** 60+
- **Activities-** Maintain practice facility and overall presentation to members, help with daily setup throughout course, assist with applications, and fulfill any irrigation requirements.
- **Expectations/Opportunities-** Exposure to chemical and fertilizer applications (foliar and granular), calibration and cleaning practices on all sprayers, weed assessment and control, Poa eradication practices, irrigation repairs and installation, irrigation syringe practices as needed. Equipment operation: walk mowers, triplex, fairway, trim, rough, loader, trencher. Detail work including: edging, line trimming, painting, blowing of paths and high traffic areas, cup cutting, cart sign management, trash and debris removal, and cleanliness of maintenance facility and clubhouse.
- **Overall Experience-** During the summer internship several opportunities will be available to meet with industry professionals. Tree assessment and pruning techniques for golf course needs. Equipment maintenance along with brief overview of reel preparation and preventative maintenance practices. Introduction to local representatives for chemical and fertilizer needs. The summer is intended to be a brief overview of actual programs and tournament setup at Crooked Stick Golf Club. The short stay limits the depth and detail of work done here at Crooked Stick, but should be a positive experience.
