Course Description: NCR Country Club was designed by the late Dick Wilson and opened for play in 1954. The Club has two distinctively different 18-hole courses, the North and the South. The North Course is a prairie-links style with a par of 70 and a total yardage of 6,828. The South Course is a par 71 covering 7,048 yards of heavily-wooded and rolling countryside and has long been included in Golfweek's "Top 100". The South Course has hosted the 2005 United States Senior Open, 1998 U.S. Mid-Amateur, 1986 U.S. Women's Open, and the 1969 PGA Championship.
